Welcome

It was noted that the application had been refused permission by Scottish Borders Council and the applicants had subsequently lodged an appeal. This appeal would be heard by the Council's Local Review Body.

Discussion took place and the decision of Kelso Community Council was that they were **in favour** of the application **being approved**. The vote was 7-2 (2 members being indisposed and unable to vote).
